Youth and Children Meet:

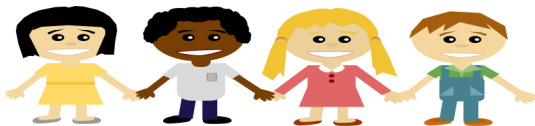
Sunday February 2nd 5-6 for a special minute-to-win-it game night and pizza party
